### **Gabbing about Life (Icebreaker)**

Who is the best leader you know and why?

### **Reading from the Book of Life (the Bible)**

Mark 10:35-45

### **Grappling with Life’s Issues (Questions)**

Spend a few minutes discussing the passage. What issues are presented in the passage? What stands out? What surprises you? Are there any passages that relate to this one?

A critical issue in this passage is leadership, but leadership is not defined as you may expect. This passage is about servant leadership. Servant leadership is the secret to kingdom impact. If you want to become great then you have to do one thing – serve.

What does a servant’s heart consist of? (Discuss and give examples from experience.) Eager to give, acting out of a higher cause, and joyful when others arrive at their God given destination are just a few examples of characteristics of servant leadership.

You have probably heard it said, “It is only when one knows how much you care that one cares how much you know.” The only way to show how you care is to serve. Using your two hands to help is often the most powerful action that one can take in any situation.

Final Thought: Do you want to be the greatest you can be? It requires a life of serving, a life committed to putting others above you.

Pray that God reveals opportunities for service and that you embrace the chance to serve others.
